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Things to recite in the morning and evening

1. According to Hazrat Uthman (may Allah be pleased with him), the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said, “Whoever recites these words three times every morning and evening:

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الَّذِي لَا يَضُرُّ مَعَ اسْمِهِ شَيْءٌ فِي
الْأَرْضِ وَلَا فِي السَّمَاءِ وَهُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ

Translation: (We entered in the morning (or evening) with the name of Allah, with which nothing in the heavens or on earth can hurt us, and He is the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing.)

have read it, then nothing will be able to harm him.

According to the narration of Abu Dawud Sharif, from the time of reciting in the morning till evening and from reciting in the evening till dawn, no sudden calamity will befall him.

Things to recite in the morning and evening

2. According to Ibn Abbas (may Allah be pleased with him), the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said that whosoever recites these three verses of Surah Room (vol-21) in the morning:

فَسُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ حِينَ تُمْسُونَ وَحِينَ تُصْبِحُونَ ﴿١٤﴾

وَلَهُ الْحُكْمُ فِي السَّمَوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ وَعِشْيَا

وَحِينَ تَظْهَرُونَ ﴿١٥﴾ يُخْرِجُ الْحَيَّ مِنَ الْمَيِّتِ

وَيُخْرِجُ الْمَيِّتَ مِنَ الْحَيِّ وَيُحْيِي الْأَرْضَ بَعْدَ

مَوْتِهَا ۚ وَكَذَلِكَ تُخْرَجُونَ ﴿١٦﴾

Translation: (Praise Allah in the evening and dawn, the heavens and the earth, even after sun-set and at noon. He raises the dead from the living and raises the living from the dead, and he provides life to the earth after its death, and thus you shall be raised.)

2. According to Ibn Abbas (may Allah be pleased with him), the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said that whosoever recites these three verses of Surah Room (vol-21) in the morning:

Things to recite in the morning and evening

Translation: (Praise Allah in the evening and dawn, the heavens and the earth, even after sun-set and at noon. He raises the dead from the living and raises the living from the dead, and he provides life to the earth after its death, and thus you shall be raised.)

He will be compensated for what he overlooked on that particular day. Anyone who recites these verses in the evening will be compensated for what he missed that night.

3. According to Hazrat Abu Hurayrah (may Allah be pleased with him), the Messenger of Allah (may peace be upon him) said that whoever recites the first verses of Surah Al-Mumin (24) and the verse of Al-Kursi in the morning will be protected from calamities and unpleasant things until evening because of these verses. And whoever reads them at night will be saved till the morning.

Surah Momin begins with these verses.

Things to read while sleeping

Before going to sleep perform ablution and shake your beddings three times, then lie down on your right side with your right hand under your head or cheek and re-cite this prayer three times.

Translation: O, Allah ! I surrendered my life to you and turned my face towards you, and en-trusted my work to you, and I relied on you, loving your favours and fearing you. There is no place of refuge and escape except you. I believe in the Book which You have sent down and in the Messenger whom You have sent.

The Beloved Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) recited this supplication to a Companion. It said that after reciting it, if your death is to come that night, you would die on the religion of nature. And if you wake up in the morning, you will receive the Khair(best result or thing).

It is narrated on the authority of Anas that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: When you lie down on your bed and recite Surah Al-Fatihah and Surah Al-Qul Huwallah Uhud, you are safe from everything except death.


A Companion (may Allah be pleased with him) requested, O Messenger of Allah! Tell me something to read at bedtime. When I go to bed, the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: Recite Surah al-Qul or al-Kaafroon, because it is a proclamation of abhorrence of shirk. Mishkat

According to some hadiths, he should go to sleep after reciting it; he should not talk to anyone after reciting it.

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According to Hazrat Ayesha (may Allah be pleased with her), When the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) went to bed at night, he recited Surah Qul Ho Allah o Ahad, Surah Qul Awozo Birabb il-Falaq, and Surah Qul Awozo Bi-rabb in-Nas. He would exhale on his palms, a little foam of saliva to emerge, and then move his hands as widely as possible around his body. He would repeat this three times, starting with the head, face, and front of the body.

He also prayed Subhan Allah 33 times,
Par Alhamdulillah 33 times, and Allah o

Ayat-ul-Kursi

Translation: Allah – there is no deity except Him, the Ever-Living, the Sustainer of [all] exist-ence.

Neither drowsiness overtakes Him nor sleep.

To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth.

Who is it that can intercede with Him except by His permission?

He knows what is [presently] before them and what will be after them, and they encompass not a thing of His knowledge except for what He wills.

His Kursi extends over the heavens and the earth, and their preservation tires Him not.

And He is the Highest, the Greatest.

Dua for Night Times

1. According to Hazrat Abdullah bin Masood (may Allah be pleased with him), Allah's Messenger (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said, "Who-ever recites Surah Al-Waqi'ah every night will never go hungry."

2. According to Hazrat Uthman (may Allah be pleased with him), whoever re-cites the verses of Surah Al-Imran from (ان في خلق السباوات) to the end will be rewarded for praying all night.

3. According to Hazrat Jabir (RA), the Messenger of Allah (PBUH) did not sleep until he recited Surah and Tabarak Al-Dhi.

4. And Prophet Muhammad Sallallahu alehe wasallam said that this blessed Surah Tabarak Alla-Dhi interceded for a person until he got saved.

5. According to Hazrat Abdullah bin Masood (may Allah be pleased with him), the Messenger of Allah (may peace be upon him) said: Whoever recites the last two verses of Surah Al-Baqarah in one night, these two verses will suffice for him, im-plying that he will be safe from all evil and unpleasant things.

Recite this when can't sleep at night

For the sake of Allah's words, I seek refuge from Allah's wrath and anguish, as well as from the evil of His people, as well as from the demons' whispering and their approach to me.

Note: When you see something nice in a dream, say Alhamdulillah and explain it to the person with whom you have a good relationship and to the wise man. So that he does not give a flawed interpretation, and if he has a horrible dream, he should spit three times on his left side, change his crotch, get up, and pray three times, saying:

Recite this dua ten times Astaghfi Rullah
and ten times Kalima Tayyiba la ilaha illal
Allaho

and recite ten times this dua:

Dua to recite before entering toilet and after getting out

Say Bismillah before entering the toilet (the hadith claims that Bismillah acts as a barrier between the devil's eyes and man's private parts)

and then recite this prayer.

Translation: O Allah, I seek refuge in You from the malevolent jinns, both male and female.

When you get out of the toilet, say غفرانك and recite this prayer:

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَذْهَبَ عَنِّي الْأَذَى وَعَافَانِي

Dua to recite before entering toilet and after getting out

**Translation: All praise is due to Allah,
Who relieved me of my affliction and

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Ablution

When start ablution so recite

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ ط

Translation: Most Gracious, Most Merciful, in the name of God.

A person who does not recite Bismillah does not conduct ablution, according to some hadiths.

1.The hadith mentions that the name of Allah should be said at the start of ablution, but no precise words are provided. According to some scholars, Bismillah should be uttered.

During ablution, recite this

Recite this dua During ablution

Recite this prayer facing the sky after they have completed ablution:

During ablution, recite this

Translation: I bear witness that there is no god but Allah, that He is the One and that He has no partners, and that Muhammad is Allah's servant and Messenger.

The eight gates of Paradise are opened for the reciter by saying this dua after ab-lution, whatever gate he enters.

Translation: I bear witness that there is no god but Allah, He is the One, there is no partner to Him, and I bear witness that Muhammad is His servant and Messenger. I am willing to accept Allah as my Lord, Muhammad (peace be upon him) as Mes-senger and Islam as my religion.

On hearing the Adhan

It is stated in the hadith that whoever recites the Adhan after hearing it, his sins will be forgiven.

-Muslim

It is stated in the hadith that the one who answers the Adhan will enter Paradise.

-Hisn

Therefore, answer the Adhan of the muazzin, say what the muazzin says, but in response to Hayya La-Ssalah and Hayya la al-Falah, say Lahawla wa La Quwwata illa-billah.

Translation: O Allah, protect me from Hell

When you say this and die that night, you will be saved from Hell, and if you recite it again after Fajr without talking to anyone, you will be held from Hell if you die that day.

In another hadith, the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said:

After completing the Fajr and Maghrib prayers, a person who is sitting in Tashahhud recites it ten times:

لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ بِيَدِهِ الْخَيْرُ ط
يُحْيِي وَيُمِيتُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ ط

Translation: There is no deity except Allah. He is Alone. He has no partner. To Him belongs the realm and to Him belongs all praise. To Him belongs goodness. He gives life, and he takes it back. He has the power over all things.

Dua after Fajr and Maghrib prayers

So every time, ten good deeds will be added to him, and ten sins will be erased from his deeds, and he will be raised ten degrees, and he will be saved from every evil thing, and the accursed Satan and nothing can destroy him except shirk. He will be the best of all people in terms of deeds, but if someone recites it more than him (the latter will be the best).

Dua while entering the house

Recite this whenever entering the house:

It is narrated on the authority of Hazrat Jabir (may Allah be pleased with him) that the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: When a person recites Allah's name while entering his house and at the meal, Satan says to his companions that you cannot stay here at night nor can take any of their food at meal.

But if he does not recite Allah's name while entering and does not mention Allah at mealtime, then Satan tells his companions that you can stay and eat at night.

Read this when leaving home

When stepping out of home, recite this:

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ تَوَكَّلْتُ عَلَى اللَّهِ، لَا حَوْلَ
وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ ط

Translation: I have come out (from my home) in the name of Allah. I have put my trust (& faith) in Allah. The power (& ability) to avoid sins and to do good deeds is from Allah.

According to the hadith, whoever reads it after going out of home is called with a (secret) voice that your needs will be met and you will be saved from loss. Hearing these words, the devil leaves him, stops seducing (& tricking) and torturing him.

Narrated in the hadeeth that by reciting it in the market, Allah Almighty will give one million good deeds, forgive one million sins, raise one million degrees, and make a house in Paradise for him.

Translation: I entered with the name of Allah, O Allah, I ask you for the goodness of the market and what is in it and I seek your refuge from the bad of this market and what is in it. And I seek your refuge from taking a false oath and facing loss here (in trading).





Translation: The hearer listened to praise of Allah (from us), and (Praise of) the blessings of Al-lah and (our) confession of (Allah is) keeping us in good condition (or health). O Allah, please be with us and have grace on us, and I seek refuge in Allah while praying.

loudly and three times.

When the morning begins in travelling

Prophet (Peace be upon Him) said whoever turns his heart away from worldly thoughts and always pays attention to Allah and keeps his mind occupied in think-ing about him, so he's accompanied by an angel, and whoever is engrossed in use-less (and meaningless) poetry and nonsense, so he's accompanied by satan.

Every surah should be started with **Bismillah** and even at the end of **قل اعوذ برب الناس** Bismillah should be added thus, **Bismillah** will be recited six times.

Hazrat Zubair (may Allah be pleased with him) narrated that whenever I went on a journey, even though I was wealthy, my luggage used to become less than my companions, and my condition deteriorated. However, when I first began reciting these Surahs (in my every journey), I used to be in better condition than my friend, and I kept more luggage at the end of the trip than anyone else.

Etiquette of return from a travel

When returning from travel so sit and recite the dua of beginning travel (men-tioned above), i.e. اللهم انا نسالك في سفرنا هذا البر والتقوى - until the end and when beginning travel so pay attention to other duas and etiquettes of travelling.

Recite Allah o Akbar 3 times on every ascension to height and then recite this dua:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ
الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ اِئْبُونَ تَائِبُونَ
عَابِدُونَ سَاجِدُونَ لِرَبِّنَا حَامِدُونَ ط صَدَقَ اللَّهُ
وَعْدَهُ، وَنَصَرَ عَبْدَهُ، وَهَزَمَ الْأَحْزَابَ وَحْدَهُ

Translation: There is no piety except Allah, He is alone, He has no partner, He has the (true) kingship, All praise belongs to Him, He is Omnipotent. We are returners, repent-ants, worshipers, and praising our Lord. Allah has kept His promise and made his servant victorious and defeated armies alone. -Mishkat

Returning from travel

After returning, when entering your town recite this:

Translation: We are returners, repentants, worshippers and praising our Lord.

Then another person came and said, “السلام عليكم ورحمة الله” The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) replied and said, ‘He has

attained twenty good deeds.’ Then a man came and said,



According to the narration of Abu Daud Sharif, when two Muslims shake hands during a meeting, and praise Allah, and pray for forgiveness, they are forgiven.

When you sneeze

Say this when you sneeze.

When any Muslim listens to this he should say.

Hazrat Ayesha (may Allah be pleased with her) said: When the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) was ill, he would recite the Mu'awzaat and breathe on his hand. And then

they used to touch the entire body back and forth. And in the disease in which the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) died, I used to breathe on his hands after reciting the Mu'awzaat, then I would turn his hand over his entire body.

Note: At the time of death, the deceased's face should be turned towards the Qiblah and the Muslim who is present there should recite "La ilaha illa Allah" to the deceased. That is, repeat the word aloud in front of him so that he can hear and recite it.

Warning: It is not obligatory to recite the Kalima at the time of death. If one does not read, his faith will not change.

According to the hadith, the one whose last word is La ilaha illallah will enter Paradise, that is, he will be saved from being punished for his sins and there will be no obstacles in entering Paradise. **-Hisn Haseen**

When one of the people present recites Surah Yaseen at the time of death, it makes for the deceased easy to die.

When the soul flies out

Close the eyes of person and read this after he passes away.

اَللّٰهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِفُلَانٍ وَّارْفَعْ دَرَجَتَهُ
فِي الْمَهْدِيَّيْنِ، وَاخْلُفْهُ فِي عَقِبِهِ فِي الْغَايِرَيْنِ،
وَاعْفِرْ لَنَا وَلَهُ يَا رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ وَاَفْسَحْ
لَهُ فِي قَبْرِهِ، وَنَوِّرْ لَهُ فِيهِ

Translation: O Allah, forgive him and raises him to the rank of your enlightened servants. And make a caliph from among his heirs after him. And, O Lord of the worlds, forgive us and Him. And enlarge his grave. And flood it with light.

When the soul flies out...

This prayer was recited by the Holy Prophet (peace be upon him) after the death of Hazrat Abu Salma (May Allah be pleased with him) while closing his eyes. And mentioned his name.

When a Muslim recites this prayer for someone. So mention his name and Add “ل” before the name for example, if someone’s name is Abdullah, then say “لعبدا لله”.

Prayers for the family of the deceased

Every man in the house of the dead pray for himself with these words.

اللَّهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِي وَلَهُ، وَأَعْقِبْنِي مِنْهُ عُقْبَى حَسَنَةً ط

Translation: O Allah, forgive me and him and grant me a better substitute after him. **-Hisn**

Say Bismillah while placing the corpse on a board or carrying the body.

When someone's child dies, say Alhamdulillah and say Inna Lillahi Wa inna Ilehi Rajioon.

By doing so, Allah instructs the angels to construct a house in Paradise for My servant and name it Bait-ul-Hamd.

1. These words should be read in times of trouble.

While keeping the death in the grave

Read this While keeping the death in the grave

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَبِاللَّهِ وَعَلَى مِلَّةِ رَسُولِ اللَّهِ

Translation: I bury him in the name of Allah with the help of Allah and the manner of the Messenger of Allah.

Note: After the burial, recite verses of Surah Al-Fatihah and the beginning verses of Surah Al-Baqarah to the "المفلحون".

And recite the last verses of Surah Baqarah from "آمن الرسول" to the end of Surah, while standing at the feet of deceased.

And stay near the grave for a while and recite Istighfar for the deceased and pray to Allah Almighty for him to be consistent in answering the angels' questions. -Hisn

Prayer for burying the grave

مِنْهَا خَلَقْنَاكُمْ وَفِيهَا نُعِيدُكُمْ وَمِنْهَا نُخْرِجُكُمْ
ثَارَةً أُخْرَى

Translation: From it (soil) We created you, and into it you shall enter, and from it We shall bring you back to life.

Pour the soil into the grave three times.

recite “ومنها خلقنكم” the first time,
“وفيهما نعيدكم” the second time and
“ومنها نخرجكم تارة اخرى” the last time.

When you go to the cemetery

السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ يَا أَهْلَ الْقُبُورِ، يَغْفِرُ اللَّهُ لَنَا
وَلَكُمْ أَنْتُمْ سَلَفُنَا وَنَحْنُ بِالْآثَرِ

Translation: O people in the graveyard! Peace be upon you and may Allah forgive you. You have gone before us and we will follow you.

Or read this

السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ أَهْلَ الدِّيَارِ مِنَ الْمُؤْمِنِينَ
وَالْمُسْلِمِينَ وَإِنَّا إِن شَاءَ اللَّهُ بِكُمْ لَاحِقُونَ،
نَسْأَلُ اللَّهَ لَنَا وَلَكُمْ الْعَافِيَةَ

Translation: O you believers and Muslims living here! Peace be upon you and we are about to reach you Insha'Allah. We ask for peace for ourselves and you.

To express condolences

If you want to express condolences to someone, say these words after the Salam.

إِنَّ لِلَّهِ مَا أَخَذَ وَلَهُ مَا آعْطَى، وَكُلُّ عِنْدَهُ
بِأَجَلٍ مُّسَمًّى فَلْتَصْبِرْ وَلْتَحْتَسِبْ

Translation: To Him belongs what He has taken, and to Him belongs what He has given, and with Him an appointed time is for every person which cannot be changed by impatience or any other means. Therefore, we should be patient and hope for a better reward.

After scorpion stings

Once, the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) was stung by a scorpion while praying.

After finishing prayers, the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said May the curse of Allah be on the scorpion. This scorpion leaves neither the prayer nor anyone else, then He asked for water and salt and mixed salt into the water and

continued to pour it on the bitten place. And kept reciting قل يا ايها الكافرون and قل اعوذ برب الفلق and قل اعوذ برب الناس

When see a fire

When see a fire, extinguish it with saying Allahu Akbar, which means, the fire will be extinguished by (the power of) Allahu Akbar.

Pray to increase knowledge

Translation: O Allah, my Lord,
increase my knowledge.
